Refineries and Depots

- Work performed in controlled environments through the co-ordination of Internal employees
- All contractors and employees attend the Sasol site specific induction
- Sasol's official permit system is followed
- Internal training for Permit issuers and receivers (including contractors)
- Life Saving Rules applied to all scenarios and additional requirements enforced
- Pre-task risk assessments to be done for every task

Satellite Operations

- Work performed in uncontrolled environments at remote locations through the coordination of Internal employees
- All contractors and employees attend the Sasol site specific induction
- Sasol's official permit system is followed
- Internal training for Permit issuers and receivers (including contractors)
- Life Saving Rules applied to all scenarios and additional requirements enforced
- Pre-task risk assessments to be done for every task

Retail Business

- Work performed at Retail service stations which is a semi-controlled area through the co-ordination of Internal employees or contractors
- Contractors are attending the SPA training
- Sasol's official permit system is used when hot work or tank entry is performed in hazardous areas. This is co-ordinated by internal employees which have underwent the Sasol Official Permit Issuer Training.
- For all other work performed in hazardous areas including electrical, manhole entry, excavations, heavy lifting operations, working at heights, a pre-task risk assessment must be performed as per Sasol minimum requirements.
- Safety guideline document presented to service providers with detail of life saving rules and Sasol's safety requirements.
- Informal pre-task risk assessments to be done for tasks that are not classified as per those listed above.

Commercial Business

- Work performed at Commercial customers is in a semi-controlled area through the coordination of Internal employees, Customer employees and Contractors
- Contractors are attending the SPA training as well as customer site specific induction.
- The customers official permit system must be followed for Commercial installations where the issuer is the customer and the receiver is the Contractor
- For all work performed in hazardous areas including electrical, manhole entry, excavations, heavy lifting operations, working at heights, a pre-task risk assessment must be performed as per Sasol minimum requirements.
- Safety guideline document presented to service providers with detail of life saving rules and Sasol's safety requirements.
- Informal pre-task risk assessments to be done for tasks that are not classified as per those listed above.

General

- All contractors are classified as per a risk matrix.
- They are scheduled for periodic safety assessments as per their risk classification.
- During this assessment their permit and pre-task risk assessments are audited.
