- A contractor employee was dismantling shelving in a container behind the main stores when they lost grip of a section of shelving and it fell on their head, causing a laceration. Emergency orange button was pressed, and the contractor was taken by ambulance to the refinery clinic for an assessment before being referred to the Medi-Clinic because the injury required stitches.



What are the learnings for implementation?

- Stay focused on the task at hand and do not rush.
- Wear the necessary PPE when required.
- When activity requires more than one person, stop the work assess
- and ask for help before continuing with work.
