

Incident Learning: What happened?

- On 04 July 2019 at 08:40, a contractor sustained a pinch point injury to his left index finger. He was assisting with the off-loading of an Oxygen cylinder from the trailer onto a trolley to move it onto site. When placing the cylinder down it was not seated correctly on the trolley. He wanted to move the cylinder into position as it was resting on the ridge of the trolley platform. As the cylinder settled off the ridge the worker's finger was pinched between the bottom of the cylinder and the trolley platform, resulting in the injury.



What are the learnings for implementation?

- . Always keep hands out of the line of fire.
- . Always ensure that manual handling heavy objects is within capability to comfortably do the task.
- . Limit for manual lifting is 25kg, ask for assistance if above the limit.
- Always conduct your LPSCA for routine and non-routine tasks.
