Gulf of Mexico Undersea gas pipeline rupture

Mexico's state-owned oil company suffered a rupture in an undersea gas pipeline in the Gulf of Mexico, sending flames boiling to the surface in the Gulf waters.

The State oil company indicated that a gas leak from an underwater pipeline caused a spark which led to the blazing fire.

There were no reported injuries however there was extensive environmental damage.
